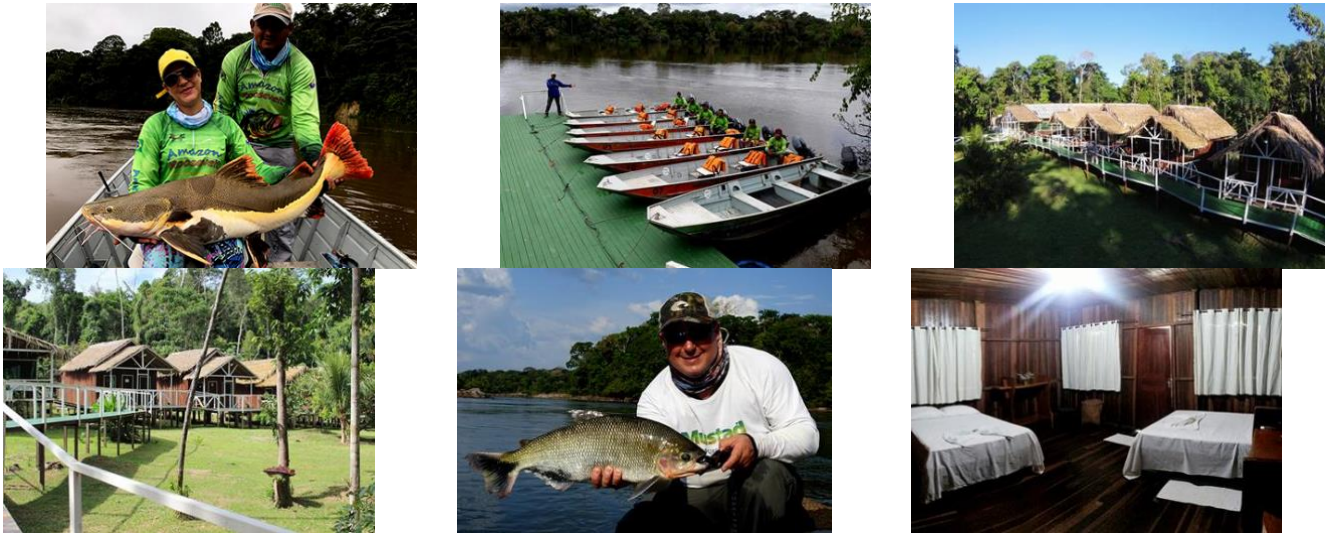


ROOSEVELT RIVER EXPEDITION – AMAZON



Come with us to fish in the beautiful Roosevelt River! This is a very special invitation, enjoying your visit to the state of Amazonas. Join us in this fantastic fishing experience on this spectacular river. At this time of year, rainy season and flooding throughout the Amazon, we will find the river in its largest volume of waters. With these conditions, our fishing will be focused on the brave and Apapás for lovers of artificial lures and fly fishing, and the strong pirararas, filhotes and surubins for those who venture in fishing with live bait. For this adventure we have two dates, the first with three and a half days of fishing and the second after the congress, with two and a half days of fishing.

THE REGION

Today the Roosevelt River is one of the best preserved aquatic environments within the whole Amazon Rainforest. It begins its course in Roraima state and flows northward into Aripuanã River, which is a tributary of Madeira River, eventually reaching the main drainage basin of the Amazon River.

A gorgeous, clean, dark watered river, full of rapids amidst a well preserved jungle teeming with life throughout in its entire course.

Like any amazonian ecosystem it has two distinct seasons, dry and wet. One of the many interesting things regarding this region is its big diversity, be it scaled fish or catfish, available for sport fishing in different periods. The strong and fast tucunares pinima, cachorras, bicudas, apapas, matrinchas, corvinas, jatuaranas and pacus are only a few of the species of scaled fish we'll be able to catch using artificial lures or fly fishing.

The entire region has great potential for sports fishing with live baits or crankbaits too with potential catches being the giant piraras, filhotes, surubins, jurupensens, jaus, Barbados and several varieties of non-scaled fish. Our adventure begins in Manaus where we'll board a 10 seat Caravan aircraft for 2 hours until landing on the private airstrip located at the inn. Every step of the trip carefully planned to offer the most practical and comfortable way to arrive at our destination.

FISHING

As mentioned before we'll use be able to use an assortment of lures, from fly fishing, live bait, crankbait and artificial lures.

INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM

- 3 and a half days of fishing.
- 2 people per boat plus guide.
- 6 meters long aluminum boat powered by an electric motor located on the stern.

- Airport-hotel-airport transfer in Manaus.
- All meals included during the fishing trip. Available beverages are water, beer and carbonated drinks (hot beverages not included).
- Accommodation in double or triple cabins with AC and private bathroom.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM

- Flight to Manaus.
- Distilled and fermented beverages (such as caipirinha, vodka, whisky, wine).
- Fishing equipment of any kind.
- Telephone calls.
- Tipping (5% tipping is the recommended rate during the fishing trip).
- Live bait (Available for purchase at the inn: tuvira, matrinchã, minhocucu).



SCHEDULING OPTIONS

1 – Before B.E.S.T. (3, 5 days of fishing)

- 28/02 – Arrival at Manaus
- 29/02 – Manaus/Inn flight. Check-in. Fishing on the afternoon.
- 01/03 – Fishing
- 02/03 – Fishing
- 03/03 – Fishing
- 04/03 – Return to Manaus during the morning

2 – After B.E.S.T. (2, 5 days of fishing)

- 08/03 – Manaus/Inn flight. Check-in. Fishing on the afternoon.
- 09/03 – Fishing
- 10/03 – Fishing
- 11/03 – Return to Manaus during the morning

Maximum of 20 people per group

Caravan flight for 10 people (15 kg of luggage per person, weighted individually before boarding)

NECESSARY DOCUMENTS necessários:

International certificate of vaccination against yellow fever.

Passport due to expire in at least 6 months before entering Brazil.

Locals should have an ID in perfect conditions and issued at least 10 years prior.

SEASONS:

Non scaled fish: January – may

Apapas: March – may

Scaled fish: August – November
